## 1. Find His <u>FAVOR</u>.

Luke 1:28 <sup>28</sup> And he came to her and said, "Greetings, O favored one the Lord is with you!"

<u>Luke 1:29-30</u> <sup>29</sup> But she was greatly troubled at the saying, and tried to discern what sort of greeting this might be. <sup>30</sup> And the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God.

<u>Ephesians 2:8-10</u> <sup>8</sup> For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, <sup>9</sup> not a result of works, so that no one may boast. <sup>10</sup> For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

## 2. BELIEVE Him.

Luke 1:34 And Mary said to the angel, "How will this be, since I am a virgin?"

<u>Luke 1:35-37</u> <sup>35</sup> And the angel answered her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be called holy—the Son of God. <sup>36</sup> And behold, your relative Elizabeth in her old age has also conceived a son, and this is the sixth month with her who was called barren. <sup>37</sup> For nothing will be impossible with God."

<u>Luke 1:38</u> <sup>38</sup> And Mary said, "Behold, I am the servant of the Lord; let it be to me according to your word." And the angel departed from her.

Mark 9:24 Immediately the father of the child cried out and said, "I believe; help my unbelief!"

## 3. Get godly HELP.

<u>Luke 1:39-40</u> <sup>39</sup> In those days Mary arose and went with haste into the hill country, to a town in Judah, <sup>40</sup> and she entered the house of Zechariah and greeted Elizabeth.

<u>Ecclesiastes 4:9-10,12</u> <sup>9</sup> Two are better than one, because they have a good reward for their toil. <sup>10</sup> For if they fall, one will lift up his fellow. But woe to him who is alone when he falls and has not another to lift him up! <sup>12</sup> And though a man might prevail against one who is alone, two will withstand him—a threefold cord is not quickly broken.
