Following God's Call

1 Samuel 3:1-10 (ESV) 06/26/22

<u>John 10:3–4</u> ³ "The sheep hear his voice, and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. ⁴ When he has brought out all his own, he goes before them, and the sheep follow him, for they know his voice."

1. Start with your **PLACE**.

<u>1 Samuel 3:1-3</u> ¹ Now the boy Samuel was ministering to the Lord in the presence of Eli. And the word of the Lord was rare in those days; there was no frequent vision. ² At that time Eli, whose eyesight had begun to grow dim so that he could not see, was lying down in his own place. ³ The lamp of God had not yet gone out, and Samuel was lying down in the temple of the Lord, where the ark of God was.

<u>1 Samuel 3:7</u> Now Samuel did not yet know the Lord, and the word of the Lord had not yet been revealed to him.

2. Listen for His **VOICE**.

<u>1 Samuel 3:5-6</u> ⁵ ... "Here I am, for you called me." But he said, "I did not call; lie down again." So he went and lay down. ⁶ And the Lord called again, "Samuel!" and Samuel arose and went to Eli and said, "Here I am, for you called me." But he said, "I did not call, my son; lie down again."

<u>Jeremiah 33:3</u> 3 Call to me and I will answer you, and will tell you great and hidden things that you have not known.

3. Make your **CHOICE**.

<u>1 Samuel 3:10</u> ¹⁰ And the Lord came and stood, calling as at other times, "Samuel! Samuel!" And Samuel said, "Speak, for your servant hears."

1 Samuel 12:21 ²¹ And do not turn aside after empty things that cannot profit or deliver, for they are empty.

<u>1 Samuel 12:24</u> ²⁴ Only fear the Lord and serve him faithfully with all your heart. For consider what great things he has done for you.

Revelation 3:20 ²⁰ Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and eat with him, and he with me.
