1. You enjoy God's grace and see how God's blessed you.

1 Samuel 23:18 And the two of them made a covenant before the LORD.

Matthew 5:45 (NCV) ⁴⁵ If you do this, you will be true children of your Father in heaven. He causes the sun to rise on good people and on evil people, and he sends rain to those who do right and to those who do wrong.

2. You see God's grace as a gift meant for you and for others.
