<u>Psalm 23:2</u>² He makes me lie down in green pastures.

1. Finding peace in God is God's <u>plan for you</u>.

<u>Hebrews 13:20–21</u> (NLT) ²⁰ Now may the God of peace— who brought up from the dead our Lord Jesus, the great Shepherd of the sheep, and ratified an eternal covenant with his blood— ²¹ may he equip you with all you need for doing his will. <u>John 16:33</u> "I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world."

2. Only by following God can you <u>find lasting peace</u>.

<u>*Psalm 23:2b*</u>² He leads me beside still waters.

<u>Matthew 6:33-34</u>³³ But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you. ³⁴ "Therefore do not be anxious about tomorrow, for tomorrow will be anxious for itself. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble.

<u>Philippians 4:4</u> (MSG) ⁴ Celebrate God all day, every day. I mean, revel in him!

<u>Philippians 4: 6–7</u> (MSG) ⁶ Don't fret or worry. Instead of worrying, pray. Let petitions and praises shape your worries into prayers, letting God know your concerns. ⁷ Before you know it, a sense of God's wholeness, everything coming together for good, will come and settle you down. It's wonderful what happens when Christ displaces worry at the center of your life.
